Come meet and discuss these topics with our diverse panel of successful ND alumni that are actively involved in advancing the energy revolution.



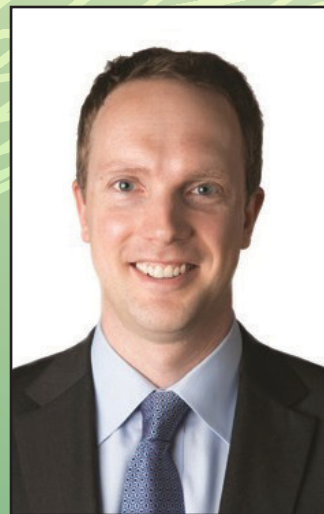
