



## ENVIRONMENTAL JUSTICE DORM COMPETITION

1. The theme of the first annual Energy Week dorm competition is “Environmental Justice.”
2. Each dorm/off-campus group may enter one horizontal slide suitable for use on screens in Duncan and other locations on campus.
  - a. Dimensions are 1920 pixels wide by 1080 pixels tall, or a 16:9 ratio, with a resolution of 300 ppi in JPEG format.
  - b. The name of the dorm or off-campus group should appear in the lower left-hand corner of the slide in a font size between 12-18 pts.
  - c. A combination of terms, words, and descriptions along with images, photos, and digital graphics may be used to convey the message.
  - d. The message should be strong enough to catch the attention of passersby and influence attitudes or behaviors.
3. Judging criteria will include the following:
  - a. Strength of message
  - b. Artistic appeal
  - c. Relevance to theme
  - d. Originality
  - e. (If a tie-breaker is necessary, a correlation between the message and Notre Dame or the dorm will be considered.)
4. Please [register](#) by midnight, Monday, August 17, so that we’ll know who is participating and can send updates.
5. **Submissions are due by 5:00 p.m. on August 20** to [ndenergy@nd.edu](mailto:ndenergy@nd.edu).
6. Voting will start August 24 at 9:00 a.m. and run through August 27 at 12:00 p.m.
7. Voting will take place in two rounds:
  - a. The first will be open to Notre Dame students, faculty and staff members. Each person may vote one time.
  - b. The top ten slides will then be judged by a panel of experts who will assign first, second, and third place.
8. The winners will be announced on August 28 at 5:00 p.m.
9. The winning slides will be displayed around campus, and the first place slide will be posted on social media.
